The IFLA/UNESCO Multicultural Library Manifesto as a Methodical Resource

Abstract. The article considers the main provisions of the IFLA/UNESCO Multicultural Library Manifesto and the possibility of its use as a methodical resource. The author states that the text of the Manifesto can be largely useful for modern libraries of the CIS countries, as they operate in the conditions of increasing cultural and linguistic diversity of society. Particular attention is paid to the "Platform for the Manifesto" created by IFLA Section "Library Services to Multicultural Populations" and posted on its website. The "Platform" is a toolkit of the methodological materials for libraries that intended to help libraries to implement Manifesto in practice. At the same time, these materials complement the provisions of The International Guidelines for Library Services for Multicultural Communities. Analysing the main parts of the Manifesto, the author demonstrates how libraries can use this document in their work with multicultural population, starting from setting goals and objectives, planning activities, and ending with the management of staff, budgeting and determining legal framework.
